Abstract:

The presentation would give an overview of the INTERPOL and INTERPOL Global Complex for Innovation (IGCI). The presentation would also cover how the IGCI will be coordinating global efforts in the fight against cybercrime. The role and efforts of INTERPOL in order to provide (i) Operational support to member countries, (ii) building capacity amongst Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) and (iii) providing Strategy and Research support to LEAs in collaboration with academia, private sector and research bodies to combat cybercrime.

The presentation would also include the outline of the some of the research areas identified in a recent workshop attended by leading experts from academia, private sector, Government bodies and law enforcement agencies.

Dr. Madan M. Oberoi is an Indian Police Service (IPS) officer of 1992 batch. He is presently deployed as Director of Cyber Innovation and Outreach Directorate in the INTERPOL Global complex for innovation (IGCI) being set up in Singapore.
